



## **Notice of Request for Qualifications (RFQ)** RFQ – External Auditing Services

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 2254 – the Professional Services Procurement Act, the San Isidro Independent School District (“District”) is soliciting Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) from qualified independent Certified Public Accounting firms to provide external auditing services for the District. The District intends to solicit qualified firms on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications to perform the required services and to retain the selected firm for a fair and reasonable price in accordance with applicable law.

The scope of services includes performing the District’s annual financial audit for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2026, in accordance with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards (GAAS), Government Auditing Standards (GAS), and the Texas Education Agency Financial Accountability System Resource Guide (FASRG), including any required federal compliance procedures under Uniform Guidance (2 CFR 200). The audit will include a review of all District funds and accounts, evaluation of internal controls, and issuance of required financial reports and management recommendations.

The engagement shall be for one (1) year, with the option to renew annually for up to four (4) additional years, subject to satisfactory performance and approval by the District’s Board of Trustees.
